

# St. Anne's Catholic Voluntary Academy Penalty Notice Fines – Government Policy 2024/2025

With the introduction of the new statutory National Framework for Penalty Notices, the following changes will come into force for Penalty Notice Fines issued after 19<sup>th</sup> August 2024. Please read the information below carefully, as this will form part of our attendance policy from September 2024.

#### Per Parent, Per Child

Penalty Notice Fines will now be issued to each parent, for each child that was absent. For Example: 3 siblings absent for

term time leave, would result in each parent receiving 3 separate fines.

#### Second Offence (within 3 years)

The second time a Penalty Notice is issued for Term Time Leave or Irregular Attendance the amount will be: **£160 per parent, per child, paid within 28 days.** 

#### 5 consecutive days of term time leave

Penalty Notice Fines will be issued for Term Time Leave of 5 or more consecutive days.

#### <u>10 sessions (AM & PM – 5 days) of</u> <u>unauthorised absence in a 10-week</u> <u>period</u>

Penalty Notice Fines will be considered when there have been 10 sessions (5 days) of unauthorised absence in a 10week period.

### **First Offence**

The first time a Penalty Notice is issued for Term Time Leave or Irregular Attendance, the amount will be:

£160 per parent, per child paid within 28 days. Reduced to £80 per parent, per child if paid within 21 days.

## Third offence and any further offences (within 3 years)

The third time an offence is committed for Term Time Leave or Irregular Attendance a Penalty Notice will not be issued, and the case will be presented straight to the Magistrates Court. **Magistrates' fines can be up to £2500 per parent, per child. Cases found guilty in Magistrates' Court can show on the parent's future DBS certificate, due to 'failure to safeguard a child's education.'**
