



This Half Term's Learning

MATHS:

- Numbers 10 - 100 including representing multiples of 10, add and subtract multiples of 10 and comparing two 2 digit numbers.
- Calculations within 20 including adding 3 addends, calculating difference and representing information in bar charts.

RELIGION:

Know that the Christian Bible is split into two parts the Old Testament and the New Testament. Understand the term 'stewardship and what it means for caring for God's world. Retell in any form the Noah story (Genesis 6:9-9:17), focusing on Noah and God's promise to all living creatures in the sign of the rainbow (Gen 9:8-17). Know that baptism is the first sacrament and that it is a sign of Jesus' love for everyone and a welcome into the Christian family.

- Using a variety of time adverbs in retells.

- Use expanded noun phrase.
- Use exciting openers and exclamation marks.

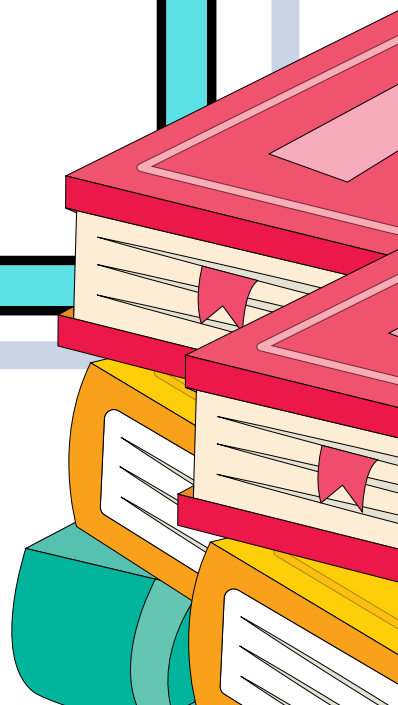
